

## Frequently Asked Tuition Questions

**These amounts are for the current school year (2011–2012) and are subject to change the following year**

1. **What is the current tuition rate?** (1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade 2011-2012 school year)

1 child (Grades 1-8)	\$ 4,490.00	\$ 4,900.00
2 children	\$ 8,740.00	\$ 9,560.00

2. **What are the specific payment options?**

1. **Single payment:** The full tuition is due by August 20, 2012, directly to the school. If payment is not received by August 20, your account will be referred to automatic monthly debiting.
2. **Two Payments:** 2 equal payments, due August 20, 2012, and January 20, 2013. If the first payment is not received by August 20, 2012, your account will be referred to monthly debiting.
3. **Monthly payment option:** Payments may be budgeted over 10 months beginning July 2012 and ending April 2013, or over 12 months beginning July 2012 and ending June 2013. Payments will be automatically debited on the 5<sup>th</sup> or the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month.
4. **Credit Card Payments:** may be made through the office for the annual or semi-annual amount.

**Parent Club Dues** \$35 per family

*(This will pay for the cost of one field trip. This fee is also in lieu of requesting food donations for various fundraising events held at the school)*

**Fingerprinting Fee (optional)** \$45

*(One time fee for parents who would like to volunteer at the school with children, i.e. at field trips chaperone)*

## Kindergarten Tuition Frequently Asked Questions

**1. What is the current tuition rate?** *(Kindergarten 2011-2012 school year)*

**2. What is a half-day session?**

Each kindergarten student is enrolled in one of the half-day sessions. The morning session is from 8:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. The afternoon session is from 11:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. Families have the option of registering their kindergarten student in the Extended Day Kindergarten Program for \$1050 annually.

**3. What are the times that they will be in the Extended Day Program?**

Morning Kindergarten students enrolled in the Extended Day Program will attend class from 8:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. and will attend Extended Day from 12:00 P.M. to 3:00 P.M.

Afternoon Kindergarten students enrolled in the Extended Day Program will attend Extended Day from 8:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. and will attend class from 11:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.
